Single user toilet rooms with a single toilet and lavatory have no functional reason to be required to be separated by sex. This can be restricting to building owners and architects who want to provide gender-inclusive restrooms. This small change to the code will allow multiple single toilet rooms to exist without a sex assigned to it.
