Substantial – The economic analysis must also include 2-alternatives, time value of money and risk analysis. Pursuant to §143-138(a1)(2) a cost-benefit analysis is required for all proposed amendments to the NC Energy Conservation Code. The Building Code Council shall also require same for the NC Residential Code, Chapter 11.

**REASON:** The purpose of this amendment is to indicate how this code relates to buildings that are constructed without required compliance to the NC State Building Codes because use of this code assumes a structure complied with minimum safety requirements of a previous code.
