3103.4 Permits. Permits shall be required as set forth in Sections 105.6 and 105.7. The fire code official shall refer the permit applicant to the appropriate agency for other applicable occupational licensing and construction permitting requirements.

REASON: Provides clarity that other trade permits or occupational licensing may be required for the intended tent use and that the fire code official should make the permit applicant aware of those requirements when reviewing their permit application. It would then be up to the other affected trades to determine if those permits are required or not.
