- include examples of innovative ideas, activities, and/or programs that make the nominee outstanding and effective.
- describe the impact that the nominee has made in the community.

Entries will be evaluated by the NCFLSE awards committee.

The award will be presented during the North Carolina Fire & Life Safety Education Conference.
