RE: 2004 Manual S, Section 3-4 Oversizing Heat Pump Cooling Based on Manual S Cold Climate

Mr. Gough:

This letter is in response to your request for formal interpretation dated December 14, 2020 that was received by NC DOI by email on that date. In the request you had the following question:

Can a mechanical system designer oversize the cooling capacity of a heat pump using the 25% allowance for "cold climates" of the 2004 ACCA Manual S, Section 3-4 without justifying such sizing from the analysis outlined in 2004 ACCA Manual S?

Remarks:

Although the term "cold climate" is not defined in the manual it is explained that the intent is to allow oversizing of cooling equipment where such oversizing is justified based on design analysis and cost over the life of the system.

Conclusions:

No, it is not possible to justify the use of the 25% allowance for "cold climates" in the 2004 ACCA Manual S, Section 3-4 without an analysis as outlined in the 2004 ACCA Manual S.
