RE: 2018 NC Plumbing Code

2018 NCPC, 403.2 Separate facilities and 405.3.2 Public lavatories

Mr. Kennedy:

This letter is in response to your request for formal interpretation dated April 13, 2022 that was received in NCDOI by email on April 14, 2022. Your request for formal interpretation states:

"Hi David. Respectfully, Cluck would like to appeal an interpretation of the Building Code, specifically the interpretation of Separate facilities for Hand Washing. We have prepared a comprehensive document, please see attached."

Remarks:

Code sections noted in this letter are referring to the 2018 edition of the NC Plumbing Code unless otherwise noted.

Attachment A is comprised of the request for formal interpretation as well as all supporting information submitted with the request.

Code Analysis:

2018 NCPC 403.2 Separate facilities states the following:

403.2 Separate facilities. Where plumbing fixtures are required, separate facilities shall be provided for each sex.

Exceptions:

- 1. Separate facilities shall not be required for dwelling units and sleeping units.
- 2. Separate facilities shall not be required in business occupancies with a total occupant load, including both employees and customers, of 30 or fewer. Separate facilities shall not be required in all other structures or tenant spaces with a total occupant load, including employees and customers, of 25 or fewer.
- 3. Separate facilities shall not be required in mercantile *occupancies* in which the maximum occupant load is 100 or fewer.

- 4. Except as provided in Section 405.3.2.
- 5. Where the code requires only one toilet facility for each sex, two unisex facilities may be substituted for separate facilities.

Comments: The code requires separate facilities for males and females for the purposes of privacy and safety. The exceptions are intended to limit cost and space hardships for smaller spaces and occupancies.

2018 NCPC 405.3.2 Public lavatories states the following:

405.3.2 Public lavatories. In employee and *public* toilet rooms, the required lavatory shall be located in the same room as the required water closet except in Education K—5, lavatories may be provided in a common toilet room vestibule, visible from the corridor.

Comments: The required lavatories and water closets shall be in the same room or in an adjacent room connected by openings without doors.

Conclusions:

2018 NCPC 403.2 Separate facilities and 405.3.2 Public lavatories require separate facilities for each sex and for the lavatories and water closets to be located in the same room unless the exceptions apply. Unless the exceptions apply, sharing facilities, water closets and lavatories between sexes is prohibited by the code.

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

The NC Plumbing Code - Appeal of Interpretation



Many States are based on IPC and have the same or similar code wording. However, North Carolina and Mecklenburg County have a different interpretation of those codes.

Section 403.2 Separate Facilities

Where plumbing fixtures are required, separate facilities shall be provided for each sex.

405.3.2 - Public Lavatories

In employee and public toilet rooms, the required lavatory shall be located in the same room as the required water closet.

1. Question: I was turned down on plan review for my restroom. We used a European style where the stalls are all private, but the lavatories are in a common room. Why was this not acceptable?

Answer: Section 403.2 NCPC requires separate facilities for male and female, unless one of the exceptions can be met. Section 405.3.2 NCPC requires the required lavatory to be in the same room as the required watercloset. This means the required lavatories for the women, must be in the same room and separate from the men; and vice versa. Separate facilities applies to the lavatories as well, so having them grouped is not code compliant.

Mecklenburg County interprets this differently.

Mecklenburg County interprets 405.3.2 to mean that required lavatories must be in the same room AND separate.

However, other municipalities do not add the "AND separate."

South Carolina, Colorado, New York and Washington all share the International Plumbing Code (IPC) Language. Each state does have different exceptions under Section 403.2, however those exceptions are not used in any of the examples shown. Each state follows the exact language of 405.3.2

IPC Section 405.3.2 - Public Lavatories

In employee and public toilet rooms, the required lavatory shall be located in the same room as the required water closet.

This Section of the Code is consistent for each of the Examples shown. The required Lavoratory is in the same room as the required Water Closet. The only difference is Mecklenburg County's interpretation that Separate facilities applies to the lavatories.

Every Example shown here follows Section 405.3.2, the lavoratories are in the same room as the water closets.

2018 South Carolina Plumbing Code

Section 403.2 Separate Facilities

Where plumbing fixtures are required, separate facilities shall be provided for each sex. Exceptions:

- Separate facilities shall not be required for structures or tenant spaces with a total occupant load, including both employees and customers, of 15 or fewer.
- Separate facilities shall not be required in mercantile occupancies in which the maximum occupant load is
- Separate facilities shall not be required in business occupancies in which the maximum occupant load is 25 or fewer.

405.3.2 - Public Lavatories

In employee and public toilet rooms, the required lavatory shall be located in the same room as the required water closet.



- Separate facilities shall not be required for structures or tenant spaces with a total occupant load, including both employees and customers, of 15 or fewer.
- Separate facilities shall not be required in mercantile occupancies in which the maximum occupant load is 100 or fewer.
- Separate facilities shall not be required in business occupancies in which the maximum occupant load is 25 or fewer.

405.3.2 - Public Lavatories

In employee and public toilet rooms, the required lavatory shall be located in the same room as the required water closet.



 Separate facilities shall not be required for structures or tenant spaces with a total occupant load, including both employees and customers, of 15 or fewer.
- Separate facilities shall not be required in mercantile occupancies in which the maximum occupant load is 100 or fewer.

405.3.2 - Public Lavatories

In employee and public toilet rooms, the required lavatory shall be located in the same room as the required water closet.



2020 Plumbing Code of New York State (NY)

403.2 Separate Facilities

Where plumbing fixtures are required, separate facilities shall be provided for each sex.

- Separate facilities shall not be required for dwelling units and sleeping units.
- · Separate facilities shall not be required for structures or tenant spaces with a total occupant load, including both employees and customers, of 15 or fewer.
- · Separate facilities shall not be required in mercantile occupancies in which the maximum occupant load is 100 or fewer
- Separate facilities shall not be required in business occupancies in which the maximum occupant load is 25
- · Single-user toilet and bathing rooms provided in accordance with Section 403.1.2 shall be designated as gender neutral.
- · Separate facilities shall not be required when multi-user facilities designed for use by both sexes are provided in accordance with Section 403.1.3.

405.3.2 - Public Lavatories


In employee and public toilet rooms, the required lavatory shall be located in the same room as the required water closet.
