COURSE DESCRIPTION

Instructor III certification is a twenty-four hour hybrid course. Success for the candidate will require time outside of class to prepare for each section and complete required reading, as well as engagement in supplemental information that is provided to support the text and classroom discussion. Instructors will provide insightful, real world experience to supplement the text and support the objectives. Instructor III is Direct Delivery internal request on the OSFM website. COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Instructor III is a 24 hour, in class course with a pre-course work assignments through Moodle. Completion of pre-course work is required to continue to the classroom portion. Successful completion of this course includes 100% attendance , 100% practical completion in conjunction with a minimum score of 70% on the written exam. Scheduling shall be coordinated with Katherine Burton for delivery of practicals and the written exam.

PRE-REQUISITES

Candidates must be at least 21 years old, must have completed the NC TIMS course, must have a high school diploma or equivalent recognized by the NC Department of Public Instruction (i.e., GED), and certified as an Instructor II for a minimum of 2 years.

LOGISTICAL REQUIREMENTS

This class is conducted in a classroom setting and requires the ability to move tables for group activities and breakout sessions. The maximum number of candidates for Instructor III is 30.
