



COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Fire Officer IV certification course is a self-study course that will require preparation for each section, required reading, as well as engagement in supplemental information that is provided to support the text. Fire Officer IV is Direct Delivery and is offered annually.

Phase I: Orientation (Indoctrination class)

Phase II: Completion of application packet within one year of attending the orientation class. The candidate is required to meet a set of deadlines throughout the year for Phase II. If deadlines are met and work is complete the candidate will continue to Phase III

Phase III Attend the two-day Practical examination process

Phase IV: Written examination

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Successful completion of the course requires 100% practical completion (final project presentation), a minimum score of 70% on the written exam, 100% attendance, as well as completion of a indoctrination class. Scheduling shall be coordinated with Lance Foulk for delivery of practicals and the written exam.

PRE-REQUISITES

Candidates must be certified in Firefighter for a minimum of nine years, and Fire Officer III certified.
