Tempered Glass Next to Doors

Code: 2012 Residential Code **Date:** July 2, 2012

Section: R308.4

Question:

If a window is located within 24" of a door, is tempered glass required?

Answer:

Item #2 of NCRC Section R308.4 reads as follows:

Glazing in an individual fixed or operable panel adjacent to a door where the nearest vertical edge is within 24-inches (610 mm) of the door in a closed position and whose bottom edge is less than 60 inches (1524 mm) above the floor or walking surface.

Exceptions:

- 1. Decorative glazing.
- 2. When there is an intervening wall or other permanent barrier between the door and the glazing.
- 3. Glazing in walls on the latch side of and perpendicular to the plane of the door in a closed position.
- 4. Glazing adjacent to a door where access through the door is to a closet or storage area 3 feet (914 mm) or less in depth.
- 5. Glazing that is adjacent to the fixed panel of patio doors.

This glazing is required for purposes of occupant safety.
