## Tempered Glass for Windows 9 Square Feet or More

Code: 2012 Residential Code
Date: July 2, 2012
Section: R308.4

## Question:

If a window is 9 square feet or more, does it have to be tempered?

## Answer:

Section R308.4, Item 3: Glazing that meets all the following must be tempered or safety glazing which meets CPSC 16 CFR Part 1201:
3.1. Exposed area of a single pane greater than 9 square feet. (For example, this could be a single sash of a double hung window).
3.2. Bottom edge of the glass is lower than $18^{\prime \prime}$ above the floor.
3.3. Top edge of the glass is higher than $36^{\prime \prime}$ above the floor.
3.4. There is a floor or walking surface within 36 " horizontally of the window.

If any one of these 4 is not met, then the window is not required to be tempered by condition \#3.
