Friday Nov. 13th 8:00 AM – Sunday Nov. 15th 5:00PM

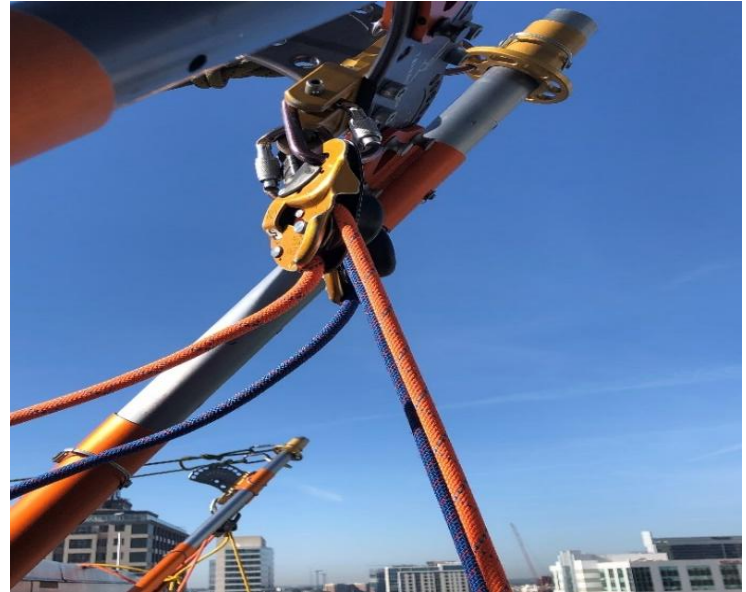
This class will be very physical. All participants will be expected to ascend and descend multiple times each day.
